1	Q. Our company will submit bid as exclusive distributor of a foreign manufacturer, our concern is that our company is not an ISO 9000 Certified. Based on the requirement under the Post qualification Checklist, can we submit the ISO 9000 certification of our foreign manufacturer?	Section IX. PQ, Inspection and Acceptance Checklist
	A. As per Section VII. (Technical specification) of the bidding document, the project does not require ISO 9000 Certification from prospective bidders. In this regard, the requirement for ISO 9000 Certification as stated in Section IX. PQ, Inspection and Acceptance Checklist of the bidding document is hereby deleted .	
2	Q. The Aerial Camera Acquisition Project is required to be delivered 90 calendar days after the opening of the Letter of credit. We wish to request that the delivery period of 90 calendar days be revised to 90 working days.	Section VI Schedule of Requirement
	A. No. The End User requires the delivery period to be 90 calendar days.	
3	Q. Our company supplied and installed surveillance radar in Tagaytay, under CAAP which is more than the amount of the ABC for this project. We wish to know if the said contract is acceptable to the procuring entity?	Section II ITB. Clause 5 & 12 (a) (iii)
	A. To be declared an eligible bidder for the procurement of goods, the prospective bidder must have completed, within the last three

	<p>(3) years, a single contract that is similar to the contract to be bid, and whose value must be at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC.</p> <p>The supply and installation of surveillance radar, despite having a contract price of more than the ABC, is not considered as a similar project and therefore could not satisfy the specific eligibility requirement as stated above.</p>	
4	<p>Q. Please confirm the size of the cabin door. The Technical Specification indicated that the cabin door has a dimension of 22 inches in height and 20 inches wide.</p> <p>A. The cabin door of the TC-690A has a dimension of 47 inches in height and a width of 26 ½ inches.</p> <p>In this regard, Item 7 (Camera Ports) of Section VII. Technical Specification of the bidding Document is hereby amended to read:</p> <p>"The TC-690A aircraft's pressurized cabins require camera ports, which must be taken into account as part of the optical system. The camera should fit in the dimension of the camera-hole existing in the aircraft measured as 26 inches wide and 20 inches long with a clearance of 5.5 inches from the flooring to the optic glass which has a diameter of 20 inches. The camera should be able to enter the aircraft via the cabin door which has a dimension of 47 inches in height and a width of 26 ½ inches. Should there be any alteration that would be undertaken on the dimension of the camera-hole for the camera to fit, it is the responsibility of the proponent to provide an ATO-certified airframe specialist to perform the job provided that the pressurization, aerodynamics configuration, and control cables of the aircraft will not be affected.</p>	<p>Section VII. Technical Specification Item 7 (Camera Port)</p>
5	<p>Q. We wish to request for seven (7) days extension for the submission of bids to give us ample time to prepare the documentary requirements.</p> <p>A. The Procuring Entity allows the extension of seven days for the submission and opening of bids. In this regard, the date for the submission and opening of bids is hereby rescheduled to February 18, 2010 at 10:00 A.M at the same venue.</p>	<p>Section I. Initiation to Bid Paragraph 7</p>
